#### **2013 GRAND CHAPTER CONVOCATION AN OUTSTANDING SUCCESS!**

Amish Acres in Nappanee, Indiana, was the place to be in early April; as the Indiana Grand Chapter met for its 168th Annual Convocation. Nearly 150 Companions and their Ladies were in attendance at the northern Indiana hotel and convention center, located in the heart of "Amish Country." It was the largest attendance of Royal Arch Masons at a Grand Convocation in some time. The country style meals and the service were outstanding; and the cost very affordable.

A Chapter of Royal Arch Masons was opened in the Round Barn Theatre by Prather No. 157 and Noblesville No. 120. Most Excellent Companion Jeffrey M. Jordan, Grand High Priest, was introduced and tendered the gavel; and the 168th Grand Convocation began.

It was a light year for legislation in the Grand Chapter. The new and revised Degree Ritual was ratified; and the updated Constitution and General Regulations were also approved.

During the Election of Officers, all elected officers were advanced one station. Right Excellent Companion David F. Wood of Plymouth No. 49 was elected as Grand High Priest; and Excellent Companion Donald Olvey was elected as Grand Royal Arch Captain. A complete listing of Grand Officers and their contact information is listed elsewhere in this newsletter.

The Anointed High Priest Degree was conferred on 27 sitting High Priests of Indiana Chapters in a fine fashion. And there were Awards...

The General Grand Chapter Bronze Service Award and the David Widmoyer Service Award went to Companion George Weister, posthumously, for his excellent service to the Grand Chapter. These were presented to his widow, Sandy; who also received the General Grand Chapter Sweetheart Award.

The Curtis Mahler Gavel was presented to Prather No. 157 for the most Exaltations of Royal Arch Masons last year.

There were also several Royal Arch Research Assistance Awards presented for continuing efforts to fund our national philanthropy. The Milford Anness Traveling Keystone was awarded to Greenfield No. 96 for the Largest Total Accumulated Contributions. Greencastle No. 22 received the John A. Wallace Traveling Keystone for the Highest Per Capita Contribution and the James B Wall Traveling Keystone was presented to Anderson No. 52 for Largest Percentage Increase.

All elected and appointed Grand Officers were duly Installed for the Capitular year of 2013 – 2014; and at the Saturday evening banquet the newly minted Grand High Priest laid out his plans for the coming year. Many of the Companions and their Ladies then adjourned to the Round Barn Theater for a delightful play presented by the Round Barn Players.

A Divine Service was conducted on Sunday morning by Most Excellent Companions Richard Lochner and Cleon Wright; and the Companions then journeyed home with happy reflections of the weekend.


### **CONVOCATION SURVEY**
